The three models are: No Wrong Door, Family Valued and Family Safeguarding. Over the two days you will have a chance to choose which sessions you would like to attend to learn from the Innovator authorities behind each of the models (North Yorkshire, Leeds and Hertfordshire), as well as from some of the authorities who are successfully adopting them. There will also be opportunities to hear and discuss insights from across the SFPC programme about effective support for families.
